

## What is the Blue Button?

The TRICARE Online (TOL) Blue Button allows authorized TOL users, users logging into TOL with their Common Access Card (CAC) or DoD Self-Service (DS) Logon, the ability to view, print, and save their available personal health data.

The Blue Button provides authorized users convenient access to their personal health data and offers another way to engage our beneficiaries in participating in their own health care.

## Blue Button Features

- Access personal health data; Explore medication, allergy, and partial demographic profile information, lab results, problem lists, and encounter data
- Tailor personal health data preferences; View all available personal health data or a summary of select personal health data
- Download and save personal health data to your own computer; Choose to save in portable document format (.pdf) or text (.txt) file format
- Print personal health data




# How Do I Access TOL Blue Button?





Log into TOL using your CAC or DS Logon.

By default TOL displays a summary of your personal health data. Select the "+" symbol to expand all of your personal health data. Select the "-" symbol to collapse all of your personal health data into a summary.

Select the "Blue Button Download My Data" icon to save personal health data to your computer. Specify the data types, date range, and file format to download your data.
