

What to ship?

- Any items allowed in unaccompanied/hold baggage: bed linen, kitchen items such as cooking utensils, dishes, glasses and silverware, iron, ironing board, small appliances, floor care items, TV, radio/alarm clock, small audio/video electronics, fan, personal items, small sports items, etc. NOTE: the housing office does not provide the items listed in this paragraph.
- Caution: quarters are wired for German voltage 220. US appliances will not work with this voltage in same of the Barracks, unless the appliance is rated for dual voltage. The 110 appliances will work with a transformer which is available at the BX/PX.
- For used household items, there are two thrift stores on post, several non-profit organizations are located off post and there are several online local websites that advertise new & used household items for sale.
- **Do not bring pets when you PCS if you are SSG and below coming on an unaccompanied tour.**

Baumholder Family Housing

- The current policy requires all SSG and below with command sponsored dependents to live on post. Also, key and essential personnel must live on post. All personnel in the grades of SFC and above currently have the option to live on- or off-post.
- The OHA Rental Allowance is the maximum allowed for your pay grade. Actual amount given will be the actual amount of your rent (or max entitlement if your rent is more). The utilities/recurring maintenance allowance may be adjusted depending on your individual contract. If some utilities are included in your base rent, this amount will be adjusted.

General Information

- Information is for Active Duty personnel serving an unaccompanied tour
- The Kaiserslautern Military Community is a joint Army/Air Force Community. While the Army Housing Office is managing Barracks for unaccompanied E1/E6, the Air Force Housing Office manages on-post and off-post Housing for unaccompanied personnel E7 & above and all types of Housing for eligible, accompanied personnel, all Services, including Army.

Categories of Unaccompanied Housing:

- Single Soldier Housing (SSH) 1+1 for E1-4; NCO rooms for E5-6
- All E1-E6 unaccompanied service members (SM) are required to live in on post barracks.
- Permanently assigned personnel in the grade of E 7 and above are entitled to reside in off post housing.

On arrival:

- E1-6 Personnel: Check in with your unit for assignment of barracks room.
- Within two days of arrival: E7 and above Personnel: Report at Vogelweh, Air Force Housing Office, bldg 1001.
- Failure to report on time could result in out of pocket expenses, which may not be reimbursed

- Pets are **not permitted** in any Single Soldier Housing or BEQ/BOQ
- Visitation - SSH (barracks): overnight guests are **not permitted**

Housing Locations:

- Single Soldier Housing consists of 5019 UPH barracks spaces located at Kleber Kaserne, Daenner Kaserne, Rhine Ordinance Barracks, Miesau, Landstuhl, Baumholder and Sembach.
- TCS (all ranks): there are 237 spaces set aside at Landstuhl Regional Medical Center
- Baumholder Family Housing
- UPH locations are within a 30-40 minute drive of each other

Quarters/room Configurations:

- Single Soldier Housing (SSH): a majority of quarters are renovated 1 or 2 person rooms with shared common areas. A few locations still have centralized common areas; NCO's are assigned a private sleeping room

- Do not ship more than 1700 pounds for E1/E4, 2500 pounds for E5/E6, as it will not fit into a Barracks room and Gov funded storage will not be provided. Authorized space: E1/E4 - 90 Sq Ft, E5/E6 – 135 Sq Ft

Basic furniture:

- Single Soldier Housing (SSH): single bed (E1-4), double bed (E5-6), night stand, chest of drawers, 2 wardrobes or closet, desk with chair, TV Stand, table lamps, mirror, and bookcase (E5-6). Each room has a 9.5cft refrigerator.
- Size of Beds:
 - single bed metric size 94 cm X 200 cm which converts to 37 ins. X 78.7 ins.
 - double bed is 135 cm X 200 cm or 53.1 ins. X 78.7 ins.

Quarters Amenities:

- All buildings have free washers & dryers, day room/lounge & common kitchen. Kitchens are furnished with stove & microwave.
- All room/units are wired for paid Internet, phone & cable TV. These paid services are provided by TKS (Cable Company).
